ABOUT THE TRIO PROGRAM

The TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) at Saint Peter's University is a federally funded program. TRIO SSS offers our students a comprehensive four-year program entitled the EDGE (Engage, Discover, Gain Experience, Excel), which features results-oriented support services. TRIO SSS is currently funded to serve and assist first generation, lowincome students and students with disabilities to persist to degree completion and embark on professional career paths or graduate degree studies.

HOW DOES TRIO WORK?

TRIO SSS focuses on supporting individuals from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, as well as those who are the first in their families to pursue higher education and individuals with disabilities. These particular groups have historically been underrepresented in the realm of higher education and have demonstrated lower rates of persistence and graduation compared to their non-TRIO-eligible counterparts.

The program provides a wide variety of services, including but not limited to:

- Individual grant aid award for eligible TRIO SSS participants
- Pre-College Summer Bridge Program for firstyear students
- Enrichment activities
- Professional development opportunities
- Supplemental academic advising
- Individualized mentoring
- Loaner laptop program
- Financial aid information and literacy
- Career planning and counseling
- Individual and group tutoring resources
- Graduate and professional school admissions

How to Apply

To enroll in the 2025 Summer Bridge Program, you must:

- 1. Complete TRIO SSS Application
- 2. Be admitted & submit your deposit at Saint Peter's University
- 3. Intend to enroll for Fall 2025
- 4. U.S. Citizenship or Legal Resident Status
- 5. Qualify for federal financial aid and have a current FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

Eligibility

- U.S. citizen, national, or meet the residency requirements for federal student financial assistance
- First-Generation College Student
- Have a Physical or Learning Disability
